




EIA is the process of identifying and evaluating the consequences of human action on the environment and mitigating those consequences.

## Section 4 of P.D. 1586

No person, partnership or corporation shall undertake or operate any such declared environmentally critical project or area without first securing an Environmental Compliance



# What are the salient points of P.D. 1586?

## 1.POLICY

Declares as a State Policy to attain and maintain a rational and orderly balance between socio-economic growth and environmental protection.

# What are the salient points of P.D. 1586?

## 2. EIS SYSTEM

All **agencies** and **instrumentalities** of the National Government, including government-owned and controlled corporations, firms, and entities to undertake an EIA for all proposed projects and undertakings which significantly affect the quality of the environment.

Declares Environmental Critical Projects and Areas and to secure Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) before commencing or undertaking projects.

# What are the salient points of P.D. 1586?

## 3. PENALTY PROVISIONS

Fines and/or penalties for every violation of conditions stipulated in the ECC and commencing projects without ECC.

- Mitigation of significant impacts













#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The ECC covers the proposed ROCKWELL CEBU-MACTAN PROJECT with an area of Thirty One Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Three (31,553.00) ← square meters to be located in Barangay Punta Engano Lapu-lapu City, Cebu, Region R07 with geographical coordinates N 10\*19\*20.5\* E 124° 02\*15.4\*.

#### Project Components:

- Reception Area/Pavilion (2 Units)- Eight Hundred (800) square meters;
- 2. Cabanas (10 Units)-Two Hundred (200) square meters;
- 3. Restaurant- One Hundred (100) square meters (part of a pavilion area);
- 4. Garden/ Landscaping-Twenty Thousand (20,000) square meters
- Parking Area- Five Hundred Fifty Three (553) square meters;
- Road- Ten Thousand (10,000) square meters;

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT**

All commitments, mitigating measures and monitoring requirements, contained in the Initial Environmental Examination Checklist Report for the proposed (Rockwell Cebu-Mactan Project), particularly in the Environmental Management Plan/ Environmental Monitoring Plan, including any modifications and/or additional information as approved by the EMB, shall be instituted to minimize any adverse impact of the project to the environment throughout its implementation, which shall include among others to wit:

- Conduct an effective Information, Education and Communication (IEC)
  Program to inform and educate all stakeholders, especially its contractors,
  workers, and local residents about the mitigating measures embodied in its
  IEEC, the conditions stipulated in this Certificate and the environmental and
  human safety features of the project for greater awareness, understanding and
  sustained acceptance of the project. The program shall be submitted to EMB
  Regional Office on an annual basis;
- Implement a Comprehensive Social Development Program (SDP) and submit a separate report together with the Compliance Monitoring Report (CMR) to the EMB RO on a semi-annual basis;
- 3. No cutting down of trees during project implementation, however, when clearing an area is unavoidable, a Tree Cutting Permit must be secured for affected trees from DENR-CENRO concerned, or earth-balled and transferred elsewhere per CENRO recommendation without prejudice to the filing of criminal complaint in consonance to the Presidential Decree (PD) 705, Executive Order (EO) 23 and other existing forestry laws, rules and regulations. Necessary documents such as clearance from the Secretary, balling permit etc., must be secured prior to the implementation of the project;
- 4. Establishment of a reforestation and carbon sink program using endemic/indigenous species to mitigate greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions of the project in line with the DENR's thrust for GHG emissions reduction programs and National Greening Program. The proponent shall establish a nursery program for the seedling production of Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Eight (7,888) in support to the Green Philippines Master Plan which will be utilized for tree planting activities. The program shall be submitted to EMB RO six (6) months prior to the project implementation; As proof of compliance, geotag pictures of the tree planting area and CENRO Certification should be secured and submitted to this Office accordingly;

- Deemed to significantly affect the quality of environment being located in an Environmentally Critical Area (ECA)
- Required to secure an ECC
- Processing done online via EMB Regional
   Office







## **CATEGORY C PROJECTS**

- Directly enhance the quality of the environment
- Directly address existing environmental problems
- NOT required to secure an ECC





## **CATEGORY D PROJECTS**


- Unlikely to cause significant adverse impact on the quality of the environment
- NOT required to secure an ECC
- May secure CNC through online



# Existing Projects with Expansion / Modification

Existing projects that will undertake expansion, rehabilitation and/or modification shall request EMB Regional Office for AMENDMENT OF ECC

## Examples of MAJOR Amendment

- Expansion of project area
- Increase in the project size parameter / production capacity
- Change in process flow or technology
- Additional components

#### Examples of MINOR Amendment

- Change in company name / ownership
- Decrease in land / project area or production capacity
- Typographical error
- Change in project layout without change in process/production capacity

## PROHIBITED ACTS

- Projects that start or operate without an ECC;
- Violation of ECC conditions, Environmental Management Plan, or the rules and regulations of the EIS System;
- Proponents or EIS/IEE preparers involved in misrepresentation in the documents or other presentations, and therefore breach their Accountability Statements, or commit other infractions of DAO 30-03 or other relevant laws and orders, may likewise be sanctioned.
